

URANUS – THE CHURCH IN THE LAST DAYS

To appreciate the meaning of Uranus, it is necessary to understand the meaning of Saturn and Jupiter. Saturn, with her wedding ring about her, bows in respect and adoration of her Messiah, Jupiter. Gas planets represent spiritual life. As the greatest gas planet Jupiter represents the Messiah in his first coming to earth, fully man and fully God. Saturn represents the spiritual life of believers in the Messiah, the church of Jesus Christ, in her glory at the beginning of the Age of Grace. Next gas planet along, Uranus represents the lowly state of the spiritual life of the church at the end of the Age of Grace. The spiritual numbers of the astronomical measurements of Saturn and Uranus are most meaningful when measured relative to Jupiter since Jesus is our Lord (the standard by which we measure ourselves).¹

Uranus is visible to the naked eye but is only a faint light. Originally mistaken for a comet by the English astronomer Herschel, it was recognized as a planet in 1781.

- Jesus said in the last days the lamp of the church will **grow dim**: “**Nevertheless when the Son of Man comes [at the Rapture] will he find faith?**” (Luke 18:8)

Unlike other gaseous planets, Uranus generates almost no internal heat. The heat Uranus receives from the Sun is close to the heat Uranus radiates. Uranus is colder than Neptune, a planet farther from the Sun. Uranus has the coldest atmospheric temperature in the solar system: only 49 degrees Kelvin.

- Jesus said in the last days: “... **lawlessness will abound, the love of many [in the church] will grow cold.**” (Matt. 24:12)

A most exceptional aspect of Uranus: the axis of its rotation is in the plane of its orbit – not perpendicular like most planets. Viewed from the equator of Uranus the Sun does not faithfully rise in the east and set in the west as it does on Earth. At one point in the orbit of Uranus, the Sun rises in the south and sets in the north. Each day, the spot the Sun rises shifts ever so slightly so that 21 years later the Sun rises in the east and sets in the west. The point of the Sun rising on the horizon continues to move so that 21 years after that, or half its orbit around the Sun, the Sun rises in the north and sets in the south. Then, after another 21 years the Sun rises in the west and sets in the east! For 42 years the Sun shines all day at the south pole and there is complete darkness at the north pole. For the next 42 years the north pole is illuminated continually and the south pole is in complete darkness.²


On earth the direction of travel of the Sun in the sky is important because it traces a constant line through the stars. The stars contain prophecies, both in their star names and in the pictures the stars make as a group, or as a constellation.³ On Uranus the Sun traces no consistent path of the Sun through the stars – in fact the Sun moves in a different direction through the stars every day. If we think of the Sun as the declarer and the stars as the truth – there is no consistent declaration of truth on Uranus.

- Jesus said in the last days: “... **false prophets will rise up and deceive many.**” (Matt. 24:11)

The spiritual numbers of the planet Uranus relative to the planet Jupiter:

- **Mass** of Jupiter relative to Uranus: **21.8** which means "**Brother Kills Brother**" (218)
- **Volume** of Jupiter relative to Uranus: **21.0** which means "**Lawlessness**" (21)
- **Surface Area** of Jupiter relative to Uranus: **7.57** which means "**Complaining**" (757 is 134th prime)
- **Distance from Sun** to Uranus versus vs. Jupiter: **3.69** means "**Spirit**" (9) of **Man's Rules**" (41)⁵
- **Orbital Period** of Uranus relative to Jupiter: **7.11** which means "**Spirit**" (9) of "**Martyrs**" (79)
- **Eccentricity** of Uranus' orbit: **1.09** which means "**Defender of Poor**" (109)
- **Power of Gravity** of Jupiter relative to Uranus: **2.85** which means "**Traitor Hanged**" (285)
- **Inclination** of Uranus orbit to ecliptic: **0.77°** which means "**False Prophet**" (77)
- **Axial Tilt** of Uranus to plane of orbit: **-7.8°** which means "**False**" (-) "**Miraculous Signs**" (78)
- **Rotation** of Uranus to ecliptic: **-0.72** days which means "**False**" (-) "**Evangelist**" (72)

The spiritual numbers of Uranus describe the miserable spiritual state of the church in the last days. When measured against the spiritual life of Jesus when he walked on the earth (Jupiter) the church fails. In the last days the church will lose a grip on the truth and be filled with false prophets, false evangelists, and false miraculous signs. Instead of holding on to God's word – the church will obey the traditions of the church, or the rules of men. Concerning truth the church will be in rebellion to his law – or lawless. The church will be rife with traitors – and reprisals will be meted out against them. Instead of gratitude

and thanksgiving for salvation – the church will be full of complaining to God. Instead of brotherly love – brother will kill brother, and brother will betray brother just as Judas betrayed Jesus.

The church will come under persecution. In spite of the hardening of the institution of the church there will be glorious individual martyrdoms – individuals who are faithful to the testimony of the Lord. In spite of her sins, the Lord will exercise his compassion and will defend the poor in spirit by raising them from the grave at the Rapture – which will signify the end of the Age of Grace.

MEDITATION

The apostle Peter predicted these times would come. Peter said:

- “But there were also false prophets among the people [the Israelites], just as there will be false prophets among you.” (2 Peter 2:1)
- “In the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires. They will say ‘Where is this coming he promised?’” (2 Peter 3:3-4)
- “With eyes full of adultery, they never stop sinning; they seduce the unstable; they are experts in greed – an accursed brood. They have left the straight way and wandered off to follow the way of Balaam son of Beor, who loved the wages of wickedness.” (2 Peter 2:14-15)

How then should we prepare for the last days?

- “And we have the words of the prophets more certain, and you would do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts” (2 Peter 1:19)
- “Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet’s own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit” (2 Peter 1:19-21)
- “...add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love.” (2 Peter 1:5-7)

The apostles expressly warned us:

- To uphold the authority of Scripture (the Holy Bible),
- to pay particular attention to prophecy in it, to keep our soul unstained from the temptations of the world and the flesh, to run away from greed and grasping for money in the church, with the goal always that we might love one another selflessly to the end, just as Christ loved us.
