

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Man's problem is he cannot reconcile himself to God, his sins separate him from God. Furthermore, with time Man sinks deeper in sin and farther from God. (see Theme 1). Jesus' death on the cross paid for your sins. Have you accepted God's offer of forgiveness? If not, sincerely pray: "Lord God, I am a sinner. 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THEME 2 - THE GLORIOUS CHRIST

LIFE OF CHRIST - BORN OF GOD

God promised in the Garden that the "Seed of the Woman" would crush the head of the serpent, Satan (Gen 3:15)
Significantly, the seed would not be of the Man, Adam. Sin came through Adam, so all men are sinners (Rom 5:12)
The champion of God, that would crush Satan and sin, must not be of Adam's fallen line. He must come another way.
Mary said "How can this be, since I do not know a man?" God said "the Holy Spirit will come upon you" (Luke 2:35)

LIFE OF CHRIST - ALIVE IN GOD

Jesus lived in spiritual connection with God continually. Adam was dead in sin, Jesus was alive in God (Rom 5:15-17)
Jesus said "Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father" (John 14:9) Jesus accurately displayed God to us (Heb 1:3)
The words of Jesus were perfect. Scribes and others tested him but could find no fault. (Luke 2:46,47 Matt 22:46)
The deeds of Jesus showed the compassion of God for humanity. He healed the sick and fed the hungry (Mark 5,8)

LIFE OF CHRIST - POWER OF GOD

Jesus performed miracles as a sign to the Jews that He was the promised Messiah. But, they rejected Him. (Mark 3:22)
Jesus miracles could not have been performed by human strength. Example: Healing a man born blind (Joh 9:11)
At other junctures of history, God worked miracles and signs to show the events of the day were His doing (Psa 135:9)
The life of Christ fulfilled over 100 predictions of Old Testament prophets. Example: place of His birth (Micah 5:2)

DEATH OF CHRIST - PEACE OFFERING BRINGS JOY

The punishment for sin is severe. The higher the authority offended the greater the sin, and God reigns above all.
God showed that his anger could be placated and peace could be restored with a burnt offering (Lev 1:17)
The requirement is the offering must be a male without defect (Lev 1:3). Christ, being spotless, is the only candidate.
The purpose of the offering is so "the glory of the Lord may appear to you" (Lev 9:6) and you may have joy (Lev 9:24)

DEATH OF CHRIST - THE WILLING SACRIFICE

If Christ had been dragged away to die, but resisted, we would have known God did not purpose His death for our sins.
But Christ did not resist. He turned his back to the lashing, his face to the smiters, his body to the cross. (Heb 12:2)
Christ was obedient to the Father, whose will it was that Christ be offered to save men from sin (Matt 26:42)
The Father loves the Son without measure, and to offer him up, the implication is God loves us AS MUCH! (John 3:16)

DEATH OF CHRIST - THE WAY TO GOD IS OPEN

Christ came to physically dwell with man, but the work he accomplished wrought unseen spiritual changes (Heb 9:11).
In the past, the way to the Garden and the Tree of Life was closed. Now all who believe have eternal life (John 3:16)
The blessing of the cross is not merely forgiveness, but spiritual power to have victory over sin in this life (Rom 8:2)
The victory at Calvary brought God's kingdom to Earth. The victory will expand over time to the whole world (Rev 11:15)

RESURRECTION OF CHRIST - SALVATION BY FAITH

The good news of the forgiveness of sins through the sacrifice of Christ is appropriated by faith alone (Heb 4:2, Eph 2:8,9)

RESURRECTION OF CHRIST - INCORRUPTIBLE BODY

Christ arose in a new incorruptible body. All the saints who put their trust in Him will also have new bodies (1 Cor 15:42)

RESURRECTION OF CHRIST - INTERNAL LIGHT

When we believe, we receive the Spirit of God who reveals truth to us. The light of God is now in us (John 8:12,16:13)

- 8** NEW BEGINNING (8) is the first number after THE END (7). [$8=7+1$] Christ is the first NEW MAN (8) since Adam. On the EIGHTH (8) day, a child is circumcised (Gen 17:12). Circumcision symbolizes the NEW BIRTH (8) (Col. 2:11). Christ is the HOLY MAN (8) since He is DIVIDED (2) unto GOD (3) [$8=2 \wedge 3$]. Note: All 3rd power numbers are holy. In the Spiritual Number Map, the truth triplets start counting again at one starting at the number 8!
- 9** SPIRIT OF TRUTH (9) or SPIRIT OF GOD (9). [$9 = 3 \times 3$] The THIRD (3) person of the TRINITY (3) is the SPIRIT (9). There are NINE (9) fruits of the SPIRIT OF GOD (9) (Gal 6:22) There are NINE (9) manifestations of the SPIRIT (9) (1 Cor 12:7-11) In the Spiritual Number map, a theme (9) of Bible teaching is composed of a triplet (3) of truth triplets (3).
- 14** DELIVERANCE (14) or SALVATION (14). [$14 = 7 \times 2$]. THE END (7) of DIVISION (2) or OPPOSITION (2). Genesis Chapter (14) - Abram defeats Kerdorlaomer. Melchizedek says "blessed be God who DELIVERED (14) your enemies into your hand". This battle began in the FOURTEENTH (14) year of Kerdorlomar's subjection. Psalm (14) is a prayer for SALVATION (14:7). FOURTEEN (14) generations from Babylon to Christ (Matt 1:17)!
- 15** PEACE (15) AND JOY (15). [$15 = 5 \times 3$]. The GIFT (5) of GOD (3). The COVENANT of PEACE (15) to Abraham (Gen 15:15) To live JOYFULLY (15) and at PEACE (15) with weaker brothers (Romans 15:1) is a supernatural GIFT (5) (Romans 15:13) The day the Jews celebrate their DELIVERANCE (14) from their enemies is the FOURTEENTH (14) day of the month of Adar, and the FIFTEENTH (15) day is for giving GIFTS (5). A day of GLADNESS (15) (Ester 9:18) and JOY (15) (Ester 9:22)
- 16** SACRIFICE (16). [$16 = 2 \times 8$]. The DIVISION (2) of the HOLY MAN (8). The HOLY MAN (8), Jesus, gave up His holiness by taking sin upon himself on the cross. The CHOICE (2) of the HOLY MAN (8). Jesus willingly gave up His life for our sin. The pillars of the tabernacle rested in SIXTEEN (16) silver sockets (Exo 26:25). The SACRIFICE (16) of Jesus is the foundation of our faith; it holds up everything we believe. The sockets touch the ground, so Jesus took the curse.
- 17** VICTORY (17). The 7th prime. The VICTORY (17) signified here is COMPLETE (7). It is the wondrous work of God. The Flood came on the SEVENTEENTH (17) day, in which the world was COMPLETELY (7) destroyed by God. Joseph was SEVENTEEN (17) when rejected by his brothers and dropped into a pit. Jesus also was rejected by the Jews. God exalted Joseph and his brothers bowed down to him. A VICTORY (17) of God. Joseph's famine was (7) years.
- 19** FAITH (19). The 8th prime. FAITH (19) is the defining characteristic of NEW MEN (8) or BELIEVERS (8). The tribe of Simeon received an inheritance within the borders of Judah (Joshua 19). Symbolizing people who join the people of God and receive an inheritance they do not deserve. The NINETEENTH (19) book of the Bible is Psalms, the song book of the people of FAITH (19). Psalm (19) says a BELIEVER (8) looks at the stars and the Scripture as God's perfect word.
- 20** REDEMPTION (20). [$20 = 2 \times 10$] The DIVISION (2) of the LAW (10). The Law says punishment! We are REDEEMED (20) from the curse of the LAW (10) (Gal. 3:13) by the work of Christ (Rom 8:1-4). The highest REDEMPTION (20) price was for a male of TWENTY (20) years (Lev 27:3). TWENTY (20) years of labor REDEEMED (20) Jacob from Laban (Gen 31:38). After TWENTY (20) years in the Philistine's possession the Ark was REDEEMED (20) and returned to Israel (1 Sam 7:2).
- 22** LIGHT (22). [$22 = 2 \times 11$] THE DIVISION (2) of what is HIDDEN (11). The sense here is not merely the light of the Sun that bathes the Earth. This is the Light of God, that reveals the unseen things of God to a believer's heart. (1 John 1:5) In other words, those things the Light of God reveals to believers, remain hidden to those who do not have the Light. The Song of Songs is the 22nd Book, the secrets of two lovers. Psalm 22 reveals the mystery of the suffering Messiah.
