He dines in the presence of his enemies, the false Messiah, but he extols his faith in the true Messiah, the Good Shepherd}</p> | | | | | | | | | <p>503 Saints Snared</p> <p>{When the Anti-Christ is granted all worldly authority, the lives of the saints becomes a private hell.}</p> | | | | | | | | | <p>509 Terror on Every Side</p> <p>{After the High Priest places an Idol on a Wing of the Temple and commands all Jews to worship it, there is a revival of faith as faithful Jews recognize the True Messiah, Jesus, had already come and gone. They flee to the hills to escape death at the hands of the Jewish High Priest}</p> | | | | | | | | | <p>516 No Health in My Body (Sickness)</p> <p>{The Tribulation judgments bring pain, agony, and awful suffering to the earth, but the wicked idolators will not repent and glorify God}</p> | | | | | | | | | <p>517 Man's Life Ebbs Away (Disease)</p> <p>{idolators who received the Mark of the Beast are destroyed.}</p> | | | | | | | | | <p>521 Ungodly Nation Oppresses</p> <p>{Even though God has won the victory at Calvary, the servants of the Earthly King oppress and attack the saints who serve the King in Heaven. Though righteous, the saints suffer, like Jesus.}</p> | | | | | | | | | <p>536 Rulers Are Venemous</p> <p>{All day long they twist my words...plotting to harm me."
