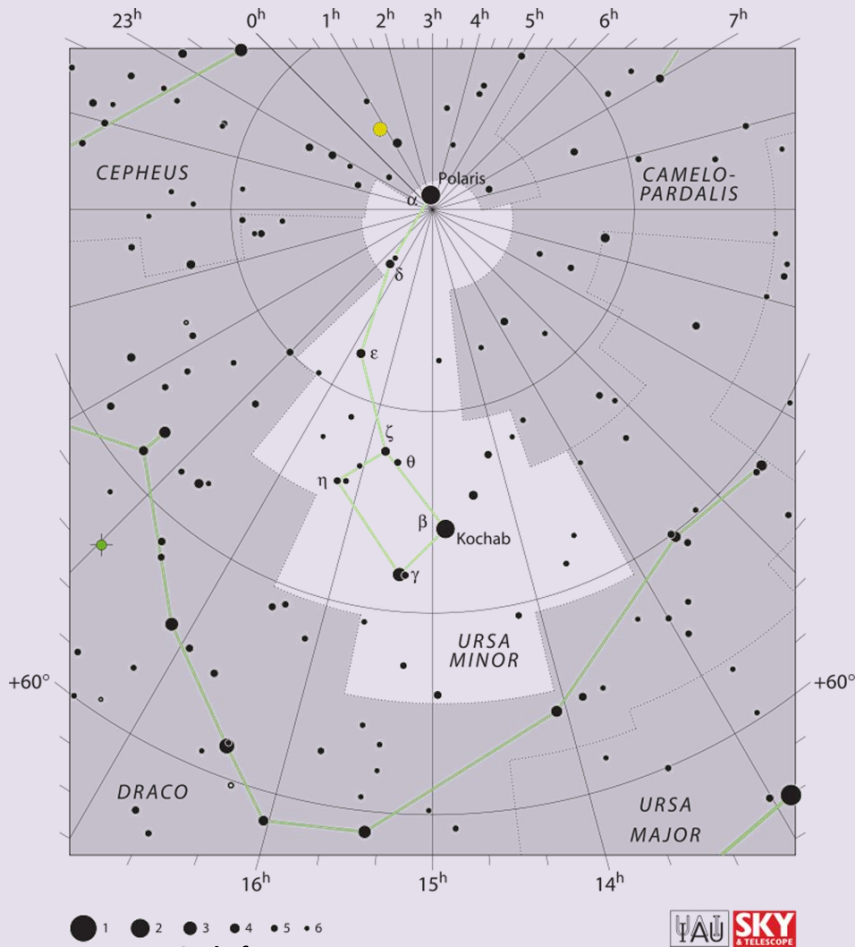

40 URSA MINOR**BIBLE NUMBER 40 MEANING:** (Our interpretation)

"TESTING" (proving the mettle, the temperament)

SOLOMON'S WISDOM: (Proverbs Chapter 30 speech on the Heavenly Signs)v.33b "And **WRINGING THE NOSE produces blood...**"**BIBLE BOOK:** MATTHEW**KEY VERSES:** ch. 3 v 10**"Away with you Satan! For it is written 'You shall worship the LORD your God: Him only will you serve.'"****SIGN DESCRIPTION:**

NOSE, PLOUGH, CLUB, BASKET, LITTLE DONKEY

NB. URSA MINOR revolves rapidly around Polaris, lit. "ringing" the star, "making rings around it"

SIGN INTERPRETATION: (per Genesis 40)

Genesis 40 is the account of the Butler and the Baker. Very appropriate for the sign URSA MINOR, which is the highest sign in the entire Heavens. The star Polaris is the anchor star of this sign and signifies the Throne of God. The two characters in Genesis 40 are intimate participants in the court of King Pharaoh, absolute ruler and according to Egyptian lore, the embodiment, the literal incarnation of divinity. (Crude as it is as a shadow, speaks of the Messiah who sits on the Throne: the God-Man, our Savior, Jesus Christ.)

In the highest Heaven there is a continual testing of the persons who stand in the presence of God. The Butler signifies those who continue to stand, the Baker signifies those who lose their place. The LORD searches the hearts to see who is genuinely His. The hearts are revealed in their respective dreams.

The Butler: "**I took the grapes** [Trials] **and pressed them** [perceived there is something worthy and good in them] **into Pharaoh's Cup** [the good in my trials being of no benefit for me but for others] **and placed the Cup in Pharaoh's Hand** [trusted God will make all things good in His time]" (v. 11)

The Baker: "**There were three** [Binding] **white** [Death] **baskets** [Bringers] **on my head** [Pharaoh]." (v. 16)
 Meaning: Pharaoh is determined, bound, to bring death to me. These are the thoughts of a servant who lacks faith in the goodness of the heart of Messiah. When trials come all he perceives is God has it in for him. When tested he rapidly loses his faith and hope. This servant cannot keep a high position in the Court of the LORD since these limited places are reserved for His closest confidants and friends.

We invite the reader to see our paper "Levitical Offerings" [on Page MY NOTEBOOK on the site] in which we show the star Epsilon, next to Polaris, is a type of Moses; also the star Kochab, at the nostril of the NOSE is a type of Aaron. In their day these servants of the LORD enjoyed the privilege of rare access into the presence of God, but their hearts were continually and microscopically examined by Him.

Bible Chapter: Genesis 2

Subject: God creates the Garden of Eden, puts man in it

Insight: It is very clear from the Genesis account that Man enjoyed terrific benefits in the Garden of Eden. "**Of any tree in the Garden you may freely eat**" but there was a test "**of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil you shall not eat**" with dramatic consequences [fall from grace]: "**for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die**" [banished from the presence of the LORD]. In the Garden the LORD walked with Adam in the cool of the day. The highest Heaven!
